**Executive Summary:** The *Central PA Talent and Innovation Defense Ecosystem* (TIDE) initiative will deliver a vibrant, highly skilled defense industrial base workforce that is vital to strengthening our national security and US industrial competitiveness. The project will stand up a sustained defense focused workforce and training ecosystem that stretches across the region. TIDE will scale the capacity and capabilities of the existing education and training system to deliver critical defense specific skills in the key occupations of machinists, skilled welders, and mechatronics technicians. To support the ecosystem, resources will also be used to remove barriers for small manufacturers to assess and deploy automation technology; connect defense career pathways for youth and underserved adults; and raise the profile of career opportunities in the defense industrial base in community.

The Manufacturers' Association is the lead applicant and program manager for the proposal. The defense community consortia will build upon the sectoral strategy that has been operating and supporting manufacturing in the region for the last 20 years – the *Advanced Manufacturing Regional Industry Partnership* funded in part by the PA Department of Labor and facilitated by the Manufacturers' Association.



**Train Defense Specific Skills:** scale the training ecosystem of the career & tech ed high schools & technical colleges



**Future Workforce:** Provide high school students career education, exploration and awareness to build the pipeline of future skilled workers



**Attract Underserved Populations:** Ensure underserved populations are recruited, provided access to the training and are connected to supportive services to participate in the training



**Technology Deployment:** support for manufacturers to assess and adopt opportunities for automation to address production barriers



**Outreach, Marketing, Recruitment:** Resources to support the project promotion and engagement of the community
