

Executive Summary: The *Central PA Talent and Innovation Defense Ecosystem* (TIDE) initiative will deliver a vibrant, highly skilled defense industrial base workforce that is vital to strengthening our national security and US industrial competitiveness. The project will stand up a sustained defense focused workforce and training ecosystem that stretches across the region. TIDE will scale the capacity and capabilities of the existing education and training system to deliver critical defense specific skills in the key occupations of machinists, skilled welders, and mechatronics technicians. To support the ecosystem, resources will also be used to remove barriers for small manufacturers to assess and deploy automation technology; connect defense career pathways for youth and underserved adults; and raise the profile of career opportunities in the defense industrial base in community.

The Manufacturers' Association is the lead applicant and program manager for the proposal.
